



Agile Operating Model 101 16 hours

Training Description

Have you heard the term "agile", "kanban" or "scrum" and wondered if your company could benefit from this type of operating model? This course is designed for trainees to grasp the concepts, principles and methods of an Agile operating model. The training will highlight the difference between traditional project management and the shift to managing ongoing product lines. This course will also provide a basic overview of Scrum Methodology including team coordination, event ceremonies, work task organization and progress tracking. Training Objective

This course delivers insights into the people, process, tools and metric techniques that are widely utilized with Agile operating models. Trainees will learn foundational Scrum knowledge empowering them to execute plans for incorporating Agile practices and techniques into their own organization. This course is a starting point for the trainee to acquire the techniques, skills, and tools that enable them to build Agile disciplines.

Skill Attainment

This training will provide a brief overview of the Agile Operating Model and its competitive key benefits. In addition, the training will provide an understanding for what foundational capabilities the company needs to get started with Agile.

- Understanding the importance of product team roles and dynamics
- The knowledge required to pursue a Scrum.org certification if desired
