



## Power Industrial Truck Safety

Onsite. Up to 6 hours. Up to 8 participants per session

### Training Description

Forklift Safety Training includes formal instruction (e.g., lecture, discussion, interactive computer learning, video tape, written material), practical training (demonstrations by the trainer and practical exercises performed by the trainee), and evaluation of the operator's performance in the workplace.

Participants will practice skills in each make and model of each forklift in each building that they will be operating. Powered industrial trucks, commonly called forklifts or lift trucks, are used in many industries, primarily to move materials. They can be used to move, raise, lower, or remove large objects or a number of smaller objects on pallets or in boxes, crates, or other containers. This includes motorized pallet jacks.

### Training

Trainings will be on site at your company. Equipment will be provided by your company as well. In addition to the training space, all forklifts, motorized pallet jacks, etc. of different makes and models need to be available during the training.

If there is more than one facility, each participant will need to practice in each building where a power industrial truck will be used.

- How to use and determine which accessories are safe
