



Principles of Leadership in Safety Level 1

Onsite – 12 Hours – Optimum class size less than 20

Training Description

This is an introduction and general awareness course designed to assist employees or supervisors in acquiring the knowledge, understanding, strategic thinking, planning, and development of safe workplace practices to include establishing a safety and health management system, culture, lead by example, reinforce positive actions, empower employees and consistent communication.

Training Objective

The objective of this introductory training will be to provide employees with a clear understanding between regulation, standards, compliance and safety workplace practices. How are decisions made, who is impacted, what are the pros and cons and impact of each category that impacts quality, productivity, moral, attendance, growth and culture.

Skill Attainment

Employees will gain management level knowledge in problem solving, effective decision making, prevention, and presentation skills that are both written and verbal.

These skills lend their way for an employee to be promoted, move into new areas of manufacturing and create new job opportunities.
