



Supply Chain Management Implementation 1

(2 Days, 8 Hours/Day- Class Size: 6-8 Participants)

TRAINING DESCRIPTION:

Supply Chain Management Implementation 1 is designed to follow on the learnings in Supply Chain Management Planning. Based on the results of that training, and your company's specific needs, the instructor will help you prepare a document that will be used to guide the implementation of your supply chain strategy to specific set of supply chains or issues. Your instructor will be dedicated to your company through this process.

TRAINING OBJECTIVE:

This training will focus on the development of your company's management team to examine your existing supply chain management and to address the higher-level improvements possible. This includes alignment with overall strategy and major internal tactical goals as well as aligning the external supply chain with those same goals.

SKILL ATTAINMENT:

Participants will be trained in understanding how a supply chain supports company goals and how to communicate that down through the entire supply chain, and how to measure the effectiveness of these activities.

TRAINING CONTENT:

Training provided will include:

- Aligning the goals of the supply chain(s) with overall strategy and major tactical projects
- Setting Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) to measure progress towards those goals, and how to gather that information
- How to communicate the goals and KPIs to the vendors and suppliers in the supply chain, and how to maintain transparency and honesty
- How to develop scorecards for the vendors and for the supply chain
- Introducing the "how-to's" of Continuous Improvement and Lean Principles to the management of supply chains

The specific training subjects may vary based upon the results of the Supply Chain Management Planning module and the specific needs of your company.
