



Supply Chain Management Implementation 2

(2 Days, 8 Hours/Day- Class Size: 6-8 Participants)

TRAINING DESCRIPTION:

Supply Chain Management Implementation 2 is designed to build on the Supply Chain Management Planning Module and Part 1 of the Implementation Module. Based on that work and your company's specific needs, we will then drill down into the tactics used to manage and improve supply chains. Your instructor will be dedicated to your company throughout this process.

TRAINING OBJECTIVE:

This training will focus on the nuts-and-bolts tactics of managing a supply chain as well as reinforcing the concepts of the previous module, especially Continuous Improvement. Several tools will also be introduced, such as flow charts and value stream mapping. Care will be taken to insure that information systems such as Materials Resource Planning are aligned with the supply chain.

SKILL ATTAINMENT:

Participants will be trained in the use of the tools and concepts that enable good management of supply chains.

TRAINING CONTENT:

The training will include:

- Materials Resource Planning Systems—what are they and how are they used?
- Supplier Selection, and their supplier selections
- Documentation of specifications for suppliers
- Contract negotiations
- Change management
- Process goals and controls and what constitutes “significant” process changes.
- Integration with lessons learned in the previous module:
 - Aligning goals
 - Setting KPIs
 - Communication through the supply chain
 - Scorecards
 - Continuous Improvement
